

Sick Policy Reminders for Students and Families:

If an Individual has one or more of the following symptoms they must isolate at home and test for COVID-19:

- Fever greater than 100.4 F or chills
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Muscle or body aches
- · New loss of taste or smell
- Cough (new, changed, or worsening)
- Congestion or runny nose
- · Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Sore throat

If symptoms present while at school we are required to send them home for the day. It is recommended that they be tested for COVID 19. They may return to school, *if they are NEGATIVE* for COVID 19, once they are fever free and not vomiting for 24-hours.

Winter break is a perfect time for our students to spend some extra time reading. Make sure those



- Whether or not the teacher is working with an emergency or conditional certificate where state certification criteria has been waived.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held, including field of discipline of the certificate or degree. If the child receives instructional services from a paraeducator, the paraeducator's qualifications.
