Class Placement

Classroom assignments are made by a team that includes the principal, classroom teachers, special education teachers, and other staff as needed. This team utilizes all available information in order to carefully select the best placement for all students. Many things factor into making the best placements:

- Academic & behavioral needs & strengths
- Student learning styles
- ✓ Peer group and social needs
- ✓ Equal balance of gender and academic ability
- Balance of class sizes throughout the school
- Information from a student's current teacher & parents

If you feel there is specific information about your child that should be considered when making an appropriate placement for next year, you will need to pick up a Student Needs Consideration form from the office. This form will be available beginning March 20th and must be returned by Monday, April 24th in order for your input to be considered. We value your feedback. It is our goal to select a placement geared toward your student's success for the 2023-2024 school year.

Please do not request a specific teacher when completing this form.
