**Bicycles** for our Most Improved students in Reading and Math, as well as Great Attendance!



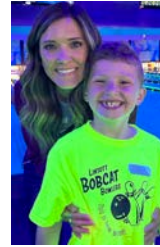

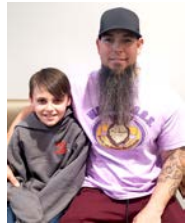
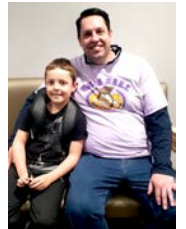
