

# Graduation Requirements

## W. F. West High School Graduation Requirements

- A. The Mathematics Requirements include a sequence through Algebra 2.
- B. The Science Requirements include 2 semesters or 1.0 credits of Lab Science.
- C. Including at least 4 semesters of a laboratory science, either chemistry or physics is recommended.
- D. The W. F. West diploma requirement is 48 classes beginning with the class of 2019. All W. F. West students are encouraged to meet the 24 credit requirement. Most universities require 48 semester classes. For the class of 2018, the requirement is 44 classes, equaling 22 credits, but that is not a college entrance standard. A one semester course is worth .5 credit. A year-long course of two semesters is worth 1.0 credit.
- E. The W. F. West Honors Program has specific subject area requirements. The current Honors Program standard is published in this curriculum guide. Graduation requirements include fulfilling testing, culminating project, and service to school and community service requirement.
